It's been a busy few months with lots of events and now with summer just officially starting we have lots more exciting things planned.

The village came together to commemorate the 80th anniversary of VE Day on Saturday 3rd May.

The event was a 1940's themed street party organised by the Hub ladies and we welcomed many of our local residents, some of whom could remember the first VE Day back in 1945.

The Hub ladies decorated the pub inside and out with lots of memorabilia from the war years, as well as brilliant creations made by the Craft and Knit & Natter groups. There was a WW2 exhibition was set up by Mr Dave Baster, including items such as ration books and local info related to the wartime activity.

Lots of people dressed in 1940's costume with Owen Roberts winning the adults best dressed prize with Betty John runner-up. The children's prize was shared between Bonnie, Betsi and Meg.

It was a Roberts' family affair with Helen Roberts winning the best baked cake. No mean feat for the judge Shawn as the competition was very tough!

Lots of family fun was had with a tombola, bingo and other games and a total of £155 was raised for the Royal British Legion.
